#### **Permanent Supportive Housing ("PSH")**

Permanent supportive housing is a proven solution to homelessness for the most vulnerable chronically homeless people. It pairs housing with case management and supportive services. The services are designed to build independent living and tenancy skills and connect people with community-based health care, treatment and employment services.

### **Resident Services**

Collective impact: On- and off-site partners coordinate to provide comprehensive and complementary supporture services to our community. Focus: We provide housingbased case management services and youth and family services to residents in permanent supportive housing. County-contracted Provider: We offer intensive

Case Management Services (ICMS) for those residents enrolled in the DHS' housing for health program.

Housing is the first step to recovery for people who have experienced homessness, externes poverly traman, mental liness, or substance abuse. Century services are voluntary, client-arven, hexibe, and focused on hepipar residents integrate in the community. For more than 10 years, Century has worked to continate these services within a collaborative network spanning multiple century properties and outside avences.
